GENERAL PUBLIC

Not a single member of the general public attended this Public Hearing

At precisely 7:15 p.m. Acting Chairman Jeanne Whalen called the Crook County 911 Rural Addressing Rules and Regulations Revisions Public Hearing to order.

Acting Chairman Whalen led those assembled in the pledge of allegiance.

Acting Chairman Whalen read a brief procedural statement to those assembled and stated the Crook County Land Use Planning & Zoning Commission members would not make a decision on the proposed 911 Rural Addressing Revisions; the decision would be made by the Board of County Commissioners.

Acting Chairman Whalen asked the audience if they had any questions regarding the 911 Rural Addressing revisions.

Mr. Nels Smith, member of the Crook County Land Use Planning & Zoning Commission took the stand and presented the three following questions;

1. How is an out building a large distance from a residence addressed?

Mrs. Croell answered this question stating that the Department would assign an address to the outbuilding upon request.

2. Do the commercial companies that offer GPS services to the public use the Growth & Development Department data?

Mrs. Croell reported that she had supplied information to Tele Atlas Map Company, one of the larger commercial GPS mapping companies, but to date Mrs. Croell has not seen any results from the information provided.

3. How accurate is the Growth & Development Department's coordinates compared to the coordinates obtained from those GPS instruments purchased by the general public?

Mr. Lyons responded the Department uses TRIMBLE GEO XT hand held units which are far more accurate than the instruments purchased from retail outlets. The GEO XT accuracy, with post processing carrier phase differential corrections, is 30 centimeters.

There being no further questions Acting Chairman Whalen closed the meeting at 7:27 p.m...
