CALL TO ORDER:

Following the close of the 911 Rural Addressing Revisions public hearing, Acting Chairman Whalen called the Crook County Land Use Planning & Zoning Commission's regularly scheduled monthly meeting to order at 7:29 p.m.

APPROVAL OF 12 JANUARY AND 20 JANUARY MINUTES:

Mr. Smith moved approval of the 12 January 2009 minutes, Mr. Lienemann seconded the motion. Staff suggested adding the words...*legislative session report identifying*...between the word WYOPASS and the word planning on page 2, for clarity. Mr. Smith accepted the addition and the motion passed.

Mr. Smith moved the 20 January 2009 special meeting minutes be approved as submitted; Mr. Lienemann seconded the motion and the motion passed.

CORRESPONDENCE

The First National Bank of Buffalo (Gillette) requested a letter from Crook County stating... "the use of spring water is not restricted by county code and there are no permitting requirements". A response letter was prepared stating ...The unincorporated area of Crook County does not have rules, or regulations, regarding the use of spring water; spring water is regulated by the State of Wyoming, Office of the State Engineer, Herschler Building 4-E, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Crook County does not have permitting requirements for the use of spring water; again this is administered by the office of the State Engineer. Mr. Smith moved the letter be signed by Acting Chairman Whalen and forwarded to the First National Bank of Buffalo; Mr. Lienemann seconded the motion which passed.

NEW BUSINESS

Mr. Lienemann moved the 911 Rural Addressing Revisions be forwarded to the Board of County Commissioners with the recommendation they adopt the revisions. Mr. Smith seconded the motion. Mr. Smith then stated he wants all the changes in the 911 Rural Addressing revisions formatted, showing where and what changes were made. Acting Chairman Whalen stated she

would format the revisions and provide the results to the CCLUP & ZC and Growth & Development. The motion passed.

OTHER BUSINESS

From information she received during the 4 February 2009 Board of County Commissioners meeting Acting Chairman Whalen reported the Forest Service received 40 comments on the Rattlesnake Project, the Grazing Allotment appeal has been upheld and a noxious weed meeting will be held at the Forest Service offices in Sundance 18 February 2009. The Commission was made aware a Thunder Basin National Grassland Environmental Assessment (EA) has been mailed out. The Commission recommended the Thunder Basin National Grasslands EA be forwarded to Mrs. Tokarczyk to draft a comment letter for the Commission. Acting Chairman Whalen requested a hard copy of the Thunder Basin National Grassland Environmental Assessment.

There being no further business Mr. Smith moved the meeting adjourn, Mr. Lienemann seconded the motion and the motion passed at 8:10 p.m...
