Call to Order

Chairman Whalen called the meeting to order at 7:11 p.m.

Comprehensive Plan work session

Chairman Whalen distributed a Goal sheet to the members. The comprehensive plan Goal discussion included the use of incentives, identification of actual problems and the identification of potential problems.

The members examined the list of items drawn from the public meetings, questionnaires and polls conducted during the stakeholder input phase of the planning process. Water quality and quantity discussion identified two issues; availability of suitable water and quality of water. The economic development discussion resulted in the members deleting economic development from the comprehensive plan. The members discussed growth management from the community side of the issue deciding to encourage a growth program that protects and preserves. Transportation corridors discussion resulted in the members deciding on Crook County coordinating with transportation corridor builders and encourages them to coordinate plans and facilities with the County. During the housing element discussion the members agreed on the housing element of the comprehensive plan dealing with efficient and effective use of existing infrastructure.

The members requested copies of the rough draft Wellhead Protection Resolution and the Tall Structures Resolution.

The members set 20 July 2009 for their next work session. The work session will be from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. in the Jury Room of the Crook County Courthouse (room reserved).
