Discussion was held concerning the CCLUP&ZC Budget Line for Fiscal Year 2011-2012. Vice-Chairman, Dennis R. McGirr moved to request \$4500.00 be budgeted for this budget line for the 2011-2012 Fiscal Year; Roger Connett seconded the motion which carried.

Joe Baron, County Attorney gave the members an update on the joint efforts between Crook County and the Forest Service to determine and establish jurisdiction for the County and Forest Service roads within the Forest Service Boundary, and that road nominations have been submitted for Forest Highway Designation.

Members reviewed and discussed the proposed changes to the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality Rules and Regulations of the Industrial Siting Council, Chapter 1.

Roger Connett moved for adjournment; Vice-Chairman, Dennis R. McGirr seconded the motion which carried. The Crook County Land Use Planning & Zoning Commission regular monthly meeting adjourned at 10:03 p.m.
