The regular meeting of the Crook County Land Use Planning & Zoning Commission was called to order April 9, 2012 at 7:01 p.m. by Chairman, Nels J. Smith.

Adopt the Agenda

Chairman, Nels J. Smith asked if anyone desired to amend the agenda, hearing none; the Chairman then asked if there was any objection to its approval, hearing none; the agenda was adopted by unanimous consent.

Approval of the Minutes

Roger Connett moved to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2012 meeting as written and presented; Robert Olver seconded the motion which carried.

New Business

Chairman, Nels J. Smith asked Tim Lyons to explain the suggested amendments for the Crook County Small Wastewater Treatment Facility Installation Rules and Regulations. Tim Lyons stated that the suggested amendments were needed because the current regulation which was approved and adopted by the Crook County Board of County Commissioners on August 4, 2004 states that the application for inspection and the application fee shall be submitted to the Crook County Clerk. This procedure changed when the Crook County Board of County Commissioners established the Crook County Growth & Development Department and designated Crook County Growth & Development as the County Designee. Commission members, Joe Baron, County Attorney and Tim Lyons, Growth & Development Administrator reviewed the suggested amendments, and some additional amendments were provided by the Commission members. The Commission members asked Tim Lyons to revise the amended draft to include the additional amendments that had been provided, and add this to the May agenda for another review by the Commission.

Joe Baron, County Attorney informed, reviewed, and discussed with the Commission members the new National Forest System Land Management Planning Rule that has been adopted by the U. S. Department of Agriculture and becomes effective on May 9, 2012. This new planning rule guides the development, amendment, and revision of land management plans for all units of the National Forest System; no action was taken.

The Commission members reviewed, and discussed other informational materials that had been distributed; no action was taken.
