All absentee ballots must be received in the Crook County Clerk's Office by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day, November 6, 2012. Here is how you can vote an absentee ballot:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request an absentee ballot by calling (307) 283-1323. • Stop by the Crook County Clerk's Office and vote an absentee ballot in person or pick up a ballot to take with you. If picking up a ballot for another person, make sure to have written permission from that person. 	<p>The following are Sample Ballots for the 2012 General Election to be held in Crook County, Wyoming on November 6, 2012. Sample ballots may also be viewed at the Crook County Clerk's Office or a copy may be obtained by calling (307) 283-1323.</p> <p>The names of the candidates will be rotated on the official ballots by precinct and will not necessarily appear in the order indicated on the Sample Ballot. IT PERMITS ANY PERSON TO PAY AND ANY HEALTH CARE PROVIDER TO RECEIVE DIRECT PAYMENT FOR SERVICES.
