<p>You can vote absentee for any reason in the State of Wyoming. Absentee ballots can be requested until 5:00 P.M. on August 20, 2012. All absentee ballots must be received in the Crook County Clerk's Office by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day, August 21, 2012. Here is how you can vote an absentee ballot:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request an absentee ballot by calling (307) 283-1323. • Stop by the Crook County Clerk's Office and vote an absentee ballot in person or pick up a ballot to take with you. If picking up a ballot for another person, make sure to have written permission from that person. 	<p>The following are Sample Ballots for the 2012 Primary Election to be held in Crook County, Wyoming on August 21, 2012.
