

**PERMIT
FOR INSTALLATION
OF CATTLE GUARD**

THIS PERMIT made and entered into for and in consideration expressed hereafter by and between the undersigned applicant hereinafter called the LANDOWNER, whose mailing address is set forth below, and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING, hereinafter called the COUNTY, whose mailing address is P. O. Box 37, Sundance, WY 82729, for the installation of a cattle guard on County Road in Crook County, Wyoming, for the LANDOWNERS convenience on the following described property, to-wit:

The COUNTY permits as follows:

1. The LANDOWNER shall pay the Crook County Clerk in advance for the cattle guard at the following rates for installation:
 - \$10,000.00 for a sixteen foot (16') cattle guard with cement footer
 - \$15,000.00 for a twenty-four foot (24') cattle guard with cement footer
 - Cost of relocating any utilities _____
 - Other additional costs _____
2. The COUNTY agrees to allow the LANDOWNER to have a cattle guard installed by the COUNTY and provide the labor, included in the rates in No. 1 above, and the equipment to install the cattle guard at COUNTY'S discretion.
3. The length of the cattle guard used will not be less than sixteen feet (16') as determined by the COUNTY.
4. After installation, said cattle guard may be maintained, extended and replaced at the COUNTY'S sole discretion at the LANDOWNER'S expense.
5. A LANDOWNER shall not maintain or clean any cattle guard without the prior written permission of the County Road and Bridge Supervisor.
6. The LANDOWNER shall pay the COUNTY each time the COUNTY cleans the cattle guard after ten (10) years. The failure to do so may result in the cattle guard being removed.
7. The COUNTY reserves the right to eliminate the location of a cattle guard at any time upon Order of the Board of County Commissioners.
