If you have a disability requiring assistance, you may vote absentee at the Crook County Clerk's Office, at the polls using the ADA accessible touch screen, request an absentee ballot be mailed to you or bring a person of your choice to the polls to assist you.

You can vote absentee for any reason in the State of Wyoming. Absentee ballots can be requested until 5:00 P.M. on August 18, 2014. All absentee ballots must be received in the Crook County Clerk's Office by 7:00 P.M. on Election Day, August 19, 2014. Here is how you can vote an absentee ballot: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request an absentee ballot by calling (307) 283-1323. • Stop by the Crook County Clerk's Office and vote an absentee ballot in person or pick up a ballot to take with you.
