Jim moved to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE NO. 2010-13

IMPOSING AN EXCISE TAX UPON THE SALES PRICE PAID FOR LODGING SERVICES

WHEREAS, Wyoming State Statute 39-15-203 and 204 allows for the imposition of an excise tax of up to 4% upon the sales price paid for lodging services which means the provision of sleeping accommodations to transient guests and shall include the providing of sites for the placement of tents, campers, trailers, mobile homes or other mobile sleeping accommodations for transient guests;

WHEREAS, an excise tax of 2% has been approved by the electorate and been imposed upon lodging services within Crook County, Wyoming, since June 1st, 1989, and each second general election thereafter accordance with Wyoming Statute 39-6-412 which was amended to Wyoming Statute 39-15-203; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Wyoming Statute 39-15-203(a) (ii) (D), since the proposition to impose the lodging tax was previously approved the same proposition shall be submitted, until defeated, at the second general election following the election at which the proposition was initially approved and at the general election held every four (4) years thereafter; and,

WHEREAS, The proposition to impose the 2% lodging tax was approved by the qualified electors of Crook County, WY on November 2, 2010 the Board of County Commissioners in and for Crook County, shall by ordinance impose an excise tax upon the sales price for lodging services; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING, to adopt and enact the following Ordinance Imposing a 2% excise tax upon the sales price paid for lodging services in Crook County, Wyoming, authorized under Wyoming Statute 39-15-204 (a) (ii), to-wit:

Section 1: Crook County hereby imposes and authorizes a 2% excise tax, as approved by the qualified electors, as imposed upon the sales price of all lodging services made within Crook County, Wyoming, authorized by Wyoming Statute 39-15-204 (a) (ii).

Robyn Finch and Wayne Garman, Members, Crook County Fair Board, gave a monthly report. Also present were Linda Schelldorf, County Fair Secretary and Mary Kuhl, County Treasurer.

Jill Mackey, Director, Crook County Library Board, gave a monthly report and discussed the Library purchasing two storage buildings and constructing them beside the boiler room by the Sundance Library and requested the Boards approval. The Board gave their approval. Also present was Mary Kuhl, County Treasurer.

Representative Mark Semlek gave a Legislative update. Also present were Road and Bridge Foreman Morgan Ellsbury, County Fire Warden Gari Gill, County Treasurer Mary Kuhl, County Library Director Jill Mackey, Homeland Security County Coordinator Jim Pridgeon, County Fair Board Member Wayne Garman, Clerk of District Court Tina Wood, Growth and Development Administrator Tim Lyons and County Attorney Joe Baron.

Kelly moved to authorize John to sign three Right-of-Way Easements for the consent to the establishment or alteration of Bertha County Road No. 12. Jim second, all ayes, motion carried.

Morgan Ellsbury, Road and Bridge Foreman and Randy Gill, Facilities Maintenance Foreman, gave a monthly report. Also present were Joe Baron, County Attorney and Mary Kuhl, County Treasurer.

Kelly moved to authorize Morgan Ellsbury, Road and Bridge Foreman, to allow five hours of overtime per week on the existing road and bridge crew, if needed. Jim seconded, Kelly voted aye, Jim abstained, John vacated the chair and voted aye, motion carried.

A public hearing was held to commence proceedings for the identification of County Roads under W.S. 24-3-201 through W.S. 24-3-206 to vacate the unused and unidentified portions of County Roads in Township 50 North, Range 68 West of the 6th P.M. pertaining to Bertha County Road No. 12, Shipwheel County Road No. 103, D County Road No. 68, Wessex County Road No. 112, Belle Fourche River County Road N. 275 and Donkey Creek County Road No. 218. No oral or written objections were received. Jim moved to approve the following resolutions:

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-14

**ALTERING AND ESTABLISHING A PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD NO. 12,
KNOWN AS THE BERTHA COUNTY ROAD**

WHEREAS on March 8, 1916 the Bertha Road was declared to be a county road at Book 3 Commissioners Proceedings page 432 and was altered on July 7, 1923 and declared to be a county road at Book 4 Commissioners Proceedings page 244; and

WHEREAS over time a portion of the road's location changed and the County and landowners entered into an agreement whereby the County would vacate a portion of the road that was no longer used, rebuild the existing used roadway and the landowners would grant easements to the County for the Bertha Road where it was altered and rebuilt; and

WHEREAS a survey is a necessary requirement of W. S. 24-3-109 even when a County Road is established by consent to show where the County Road is located; and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners requested that the County Surveyor survey the portion of County Road No. 12 that was rebuilt; and

WHEREAS the altered portion of County Road No. 12 affects portions of the following described property, to-wit:

Resurvey Township 50 North Range 68 West of the 6th P. M.

Section 7: N1/2S1/2

Section 8: SW1/4NW1/4; W1/2SW1/2; SE1/4SW1/4

Section 17: N1/2NW1/4; W1/2NE1/4; SE1/4NE1/4; E1/2SE1/4

Section 16: S1/2SW1/4

and was more specifically described in the Crook County Clerk's Office in Sundance, Wyoming, at Instrument No. 610045 Rod No. 25 Map No. 1468; and

WHEREAS the County has commenced proceedings to vacate the unused portions of the Bertha Road and other roads within Resurvey Township 50 North Range 68 West of the 6th P. M. pursuant to the identification procedure contained in W.S. 24-3-201 through 24-3-206; and

WHEREAS the landowners that were affected have signed easements and consents and they were recorded starting at Book 502 of Photos at page 221 through page 226; and

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners had the authority pursuant to Wyoming Statute 24-3-108 to alter and establish this road as a County Road when in their judgment such action shall be in

the interest of economy or the public good and the road is of sufficient importance to be opened and traveled.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of Crook, State of Wyoming, declare that the portion of the BERTHA ROAD, is altered, established and declared as the Bertha County Road No. 12 where it currently exists and was more specifically described in the Crook County Clerk’s Office in Sundance, Wyoming, at Instrument No. 610045 Rod No. 25 Map No. 1468;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the portion of County Road No. 12 located from Wyoming Highway 51 through Section 16 Township 50 North Range 68 West where it currently exists and was not altered shall remain a County Road.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED and that the County Clerk shall record this Resolution in the County Road Book and Highway Index, and abstract the Resolution in the land records pursuant to W.S. 24-3-118 (d).

WHEREAS Resolution No. 2010-12 was passed on October 6, 2010 that proceedings be commenced to determine whether or not to vacate those portions of the county roads located in Township 50 North, Range 68 West of the 6th P.M. that are generally located northwest of Moorcroft, Wyoming under the identification procedure contained in W.S. 24-3-201 through 24-3-206; and

WHEREAS the following county roads exist in Township 50 North, Range 68 West of the 6th P.M.:

- BERTHA ROAD No. 12 recorded at Rod No. 16 Map No. 990 and the portion altered by Instrument No. 610045 Rod No. 25 Map No. 1468;
- SHIPWHEEL ROAD No. 103 recorded at Rod No. 13 Map No. 945;
