**RESOLUTION NO. 2011-7**

**THE ADOPTION OF THE CROOK COUNTY ONE SPLIT REGULATION**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners and Crook County staff feels the public would be better served if a Subdivision Regulation was developed and adopted that allows for a simplified process for the creation of one (1) single Lot division of less than 35.00 acres;

WHEREAS, the Board is charged under State law with promoting the health, safety, morals, convenience, order, prosperity and general welfare of the present and future inhabitants of Crook County, Wyoming pursuant to W. S. §18-5-201; and the regulation and control of the subdivision of land in the unincorporated areas of Crook County pursuant to W. S. §18-5-301 et. Seq., W. S. §34-12-101 et. Seq., and W. S. §16-3-101 et. Seq., as amended; and

WHEREAS notice of a public hearing on the proposed rules was advertised in the Moorcroft Leader, Sundance Times and Wyoming Pioneer and the Crook County Web Site at least 45 days before the hearing and all comments heard were taken into consideration;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN AND FOR CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING, that the "Crook County One Split Regulation" is approved and adopted and that any rules, regulations, policies and/or procedures previously adopted and in conflict with this Resolution are hereby rescinded and of no further force or effect.
