RESOLUTION NO. 2013-1

**COUNTY TREASURER’S ELECTION AND BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVAL
FOR STAGGERED REGISTRATION AND LICENSES PLATES**

Whereas, the County Treasurer desires the approval of the Board of County Commissioners to elect to register vehicles in a select a month manner pursuant to W. S. 31-2-206 (e) for the following reasons:

The majority of people that responded to the survey in 2008 favored select a month registration and license plates;

The people will still have the option of having their registration and plates renewed on February 28 each year or having all of their vehicles registered and licensed during the same month each year, or a year from the date of purchasing of a new vehicle;

The commercial registrations and license plates are already staggered and there are no problems occurring with that process;

The County Treasurer is currently licensing about 16,000 vehicles in a three (3) month period and it is difficult to provide other services at the same time;

Crook County is the last county to issue annual registration and license plates on all vehicles;

If the County Commissioners do not approve the election the County Treasurer will need to hire additional staff for the registration renewal period; and

Whereas the Board of County Commissioners are required to approve the County Treasurers election to register vehicles in a staggered manner pursuant to W. S. 31-2-206 (h);

Whereas pursuant W. S. 31-2-206 the County Treasurer shall follow the procedure in W. S. 31-2-206 (e) through (g) for 2014 and each succeeding year by notifying the department not later than April 1, 2013

Whereas those registering vehicles and obtaining license plates will be able to have their fee prorated for the remainder of 2013 or for up to the next two years, select any month for the renewal of the registration and license plates, or remain on an annual basis from the beginning of March 1 through the end of February each year; and

Whereas the County Treasurer shall provide adequate publicity to county residents about the election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners in and for Crook County, Wyoming approve the County Treasurer’s election to register vehicles in a select a month manner pursuant to W. S. 31-2-206 (h).
