

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AT THE SUNDANCE HIGH SCHOOL GYMNASIUM IN SUNDANCE, CROOK COUNTY, WYOMING

THURSDAY, MAY 15, 2014

6:00 o'clock p.m. Present were Chairman James W. Hadley, Vice-Chairman Kelly B. Dennis, Member Jeanne A. Whalen and County Clerk Connie D. Tschetter.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited to the Flag.

The Board met in special session at the Sundance High School Gymnasium in Sundance, Wyoming, to attend a public hearing concerning a potential land exchange between the City of Sundance, Crook County School District No. One and Crook County and to also discuss and take any action deemed necessary pertaining to this matter.

Jeff Moberg, Facilitator, welcomed everyone and introductions were made. Kathy Lenz, Clerk/Treasurer, City of Sundance, presented the land swap details. Public comments were received. Official comments were received from the Board, the Crook County Fair Board, the City of Sundance and Crook County School District No. One. Some of the citizens present raised the issue of whether or not the fairgrounds should be moved to Hulett or Moorcroft. The Board will have Joe Baron, County Attorney, send a letter to the other municipalities in the County to see if they want to submit a proposal to the Board. Their proposal would need to meet or exceed the offer received by the City of Sundance to be considered and must be submitted to the Board at their next regular meeting. No action was taken at this time and at the Boards next regular meeting they will take action on whether or not to start the process with the land swap.

The meeting adjourned at 7:30 o'clock p.m. to meet in regular session on June 3 and 4, 2014 at 8:00 o'clock a.m., in the Commissioner's Room at the Courthouse in Sundance, Wyoming.
