

**NOTICE OF ROAD HEARING TO ESTABLISH A PORTION OF  
COUNTY ROAD No. 266, known as the Miller Creek Road**

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: The Board of County Commissioners of Crook County has resolved in Resolution No. 2014-16 pursuant to Wyoming Statute 24-1-101 to determine whether or not to establish a public highway right-of-way under the common-law doctrine of prescription in that the road was constructed or substantially maintained by the County and traveled and used by the general public for a period of ten (10) years or longer, said road right-of-way traverses the following described property:

Resurvey Township 51 North Range 63 West of the 6th P. M. Crook County, Wyoming  
Section 7: Lot 2 (SW1/4NW1/4)

and being further described on a Map of Survey showing MILLER CREEK COUNTY ROAD No. 266 recorded at Instrument No. 625866 Rod No. 26 and Map No. 1506 being sixty-six (66) feet wide where it is located on the above described property in the Office of the County Clerk in the Crook County Courthouse, Sundance, Wyoming. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all objections shall be filed in writing with the Crook County Clerk **on or before Noon on the November 26, 2014**, or such road will be established without reference of such objections on **December 3, 2014 at 10 A.M.**

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that if there are timely filed objections the matter will be **heard on January 6, 2015, at 3:00 P.M.** The sole objections to be heard by the Board shall be directed against the creation or establishment of such right-of-way under the common law doctrine of adverse possession or prescription.
