

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE
PROPOSED POLICY ON THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE
OF COMMERCIAL PIPELINES ALONG OR ACROSS COUNTY ROADS
BY THE BOARD OF CROOK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**

On **September 3, 2013 at the hour of 2:00 p.m.**, the Board of County Commissioners will hold a public hearing in the County Commissioners Room, Crook County Courthouse, Sundance, Wyoming, so that all interested parties may present written or oral comments on the proposed policy on the installation and maintenance of commercial pipelines along or across county roads.

After the public hearing, the Board of Crook County Commissioners shall take the matter under advisement to consider comments, may set an additional public hearing, may modify the proposed policy based upon public comment and or may then vote to approve and adopt the proposed policy.
