

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING TO ADOPT NEW
POLICIES FOR THE CROOK COUNTY LIBRARY SYSTEM**

Be advised that the Crook County Library Board intends to repeal and amend any existing policies and replace them with new policies governing the Crook County Library System.

On July 28, 2015 at the hour of 4:00 p.m., a public hearing will be held at the Meeting Room in the Crook County Library, at Sundance, Wyoming, so all interested parties may present written or oral comments on the proposed policies.

After the public hearing has been held, the Crook County Library Board shall take the matter under advisement to consider the written or oral comments, set an additional public hearing, amend the proposal based upon the comments received, or vote upon the proposed policies.

Reasonable accommodations will be provided for any person having a disability who may wish to participate in this hearing if they provide reasonable notice to Crook County Library System of their disability and the accommodation requested.
